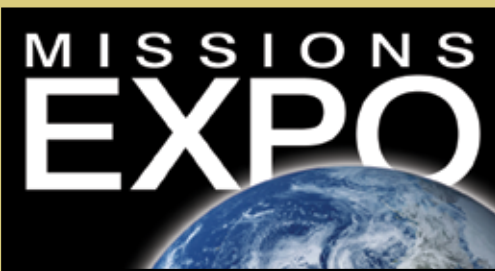

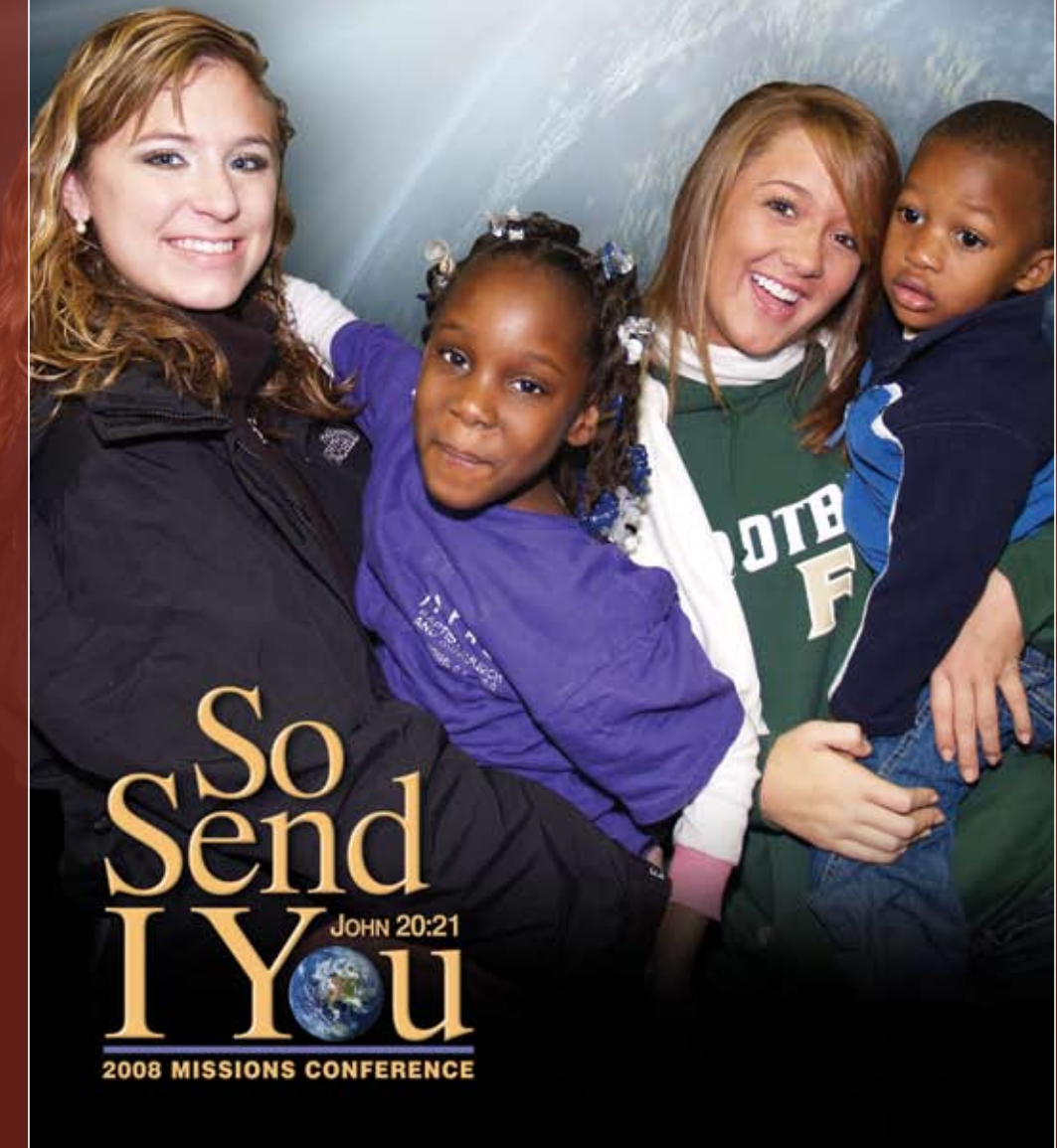

## Dr. Paige Patterson Speaks Today

Dr. Paige Patterson will bring the message during this morning's Worship Services. Dr. Patterson is the President of Southwestern Baptist Theological Seminary. He holds a Ph.D. from New Orleans Baptist Theological Seminary. Dr. Patterson has served two terms as President of the Southern Baptist Convention. The Pattersons have ministered in over one hundred countries, and Dr. Patterson has had the opportunity to share the Gospel with six heads of state, including Yasser Arafat and Menachem Begin. Dr. Patterson's wife, Dorothy, teaches Women's Studies at Southwestern.

## Dr. Wade Akins Speaks Tonight

Dr. Wade Akins will bring the message during this evening's Worship Service. Dr. Akins has served on the mission field since 1982. He and his wife, Barbara, founded Pioneer Evangelism, a missions strategy used world-wide to share the Gospel and plant new churches. Dr. Akins holds a Doctorate of Ministry in Missions from Southwestern Baptist Theological Seminary and a Master of Theology from New Orleans Baptist Theological Seminary.
